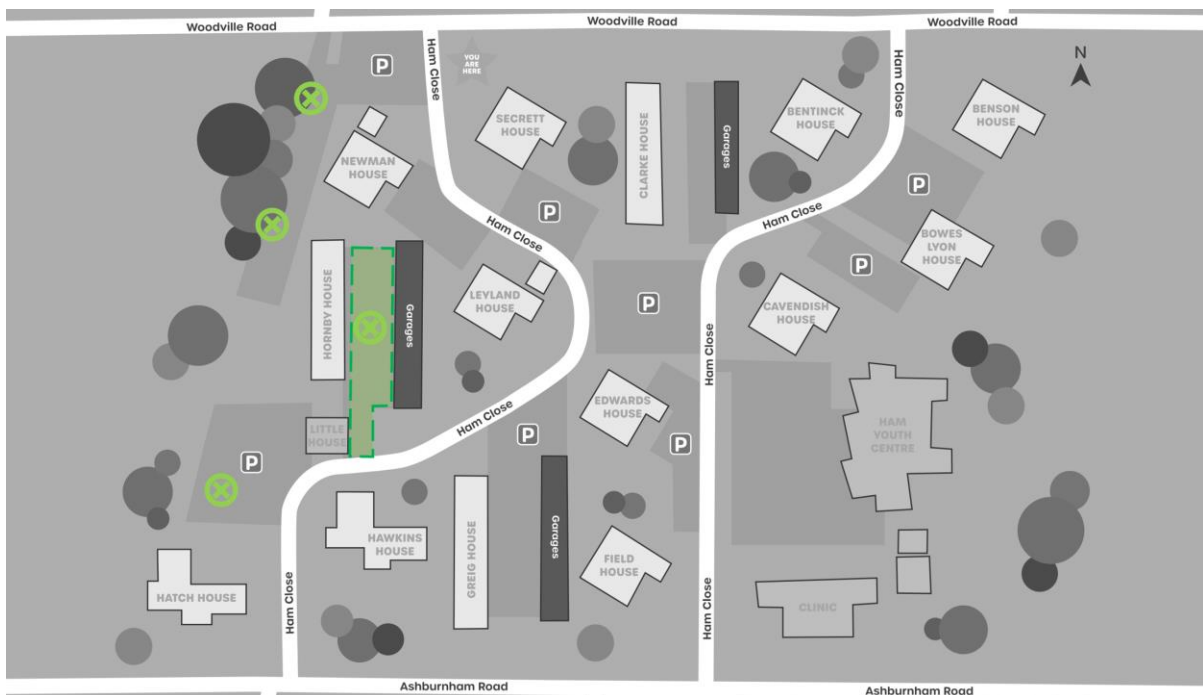
Ham Close Regeneration: ground Surveys May 2023

In preparation for the proposed start of construction later in the year, our development partner Hill are continuing to undertake a number of site surveys at Ham Close.

These works will be carried out by their sub-contractor Enzygo, and will start on Monday 22 May. The work will last for up to seven working-days, potentially running into the beginning of the following week after starting. All areas of ground being surveyed will be protected by either Herras fencing or hoarding during the survey.

To allow Enzygo to undertake their work as safely as possible, please could we ask that you and other members of your household (especially children) don't approach their staff.

Indicative locations where ground surveys are taking place:





There will be no vehicle access to all Hornby House Garages during this time as one of the deeper ground surveys will be taking place there. The area in front of these garages will be protected as an added safety measure. However, these garages will be able to be accessed on foot. We recommend that you make arrangements ahead of the ground survey works to avoid any potential inconvenience.

We also ask that all cars that park in front of Hornby House Garage, park elsewhere during these days.
